1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Chico Country Day's Prop 28 funding has enabled the school to provide comprehensive arts and music education for approximately 480 students annually during the 2023–24, 2024–25, and 2025–26 school years. Music programs and classes have included instrumental music, chorus, drumline, concert choir, and concert band. Funding has supported the cost of art and music instruction, including supplementing the school's art teacher position. During 2025–26, Prop 28 funds also supported arts media equipment for podcasting and digital storytelling projects, new gallery and community engagement initiatives to showcase student artwork, elementary art supplies, and theater enrichment opportunities. These programs expanded student access to visual arts, media arts, music, and theater while increasing opportunities for creative expression and community engagement.
