

Academic Probation Policy for Middle School Students Chico Country Day School

Middle school students may be placed on academic probation if they are earning one or more failing grades on a progress report or report card or if their GPA is a 1.5 or below. A meeting with the student, parents, teachers and Dean of Students will occur to establish the expectations and time frame of the probationary period.

Academic Probation may include the following (check all that apply)

DAILY-

- Students will show parents completed work and parents will review it with them.
- Parents will check assignments. Online/Planner
- Student will show significant improvement in work completion and effort in class.

WEEKLY-

- Parents and student will check grades and assignments on the student information system.
- Student's elective class will be an academic support/study hall class for the probationary time period.

Students on Academic Probation will be ineligible for CCDS extra-curricular activities which may include:

- Non-academic field trips
- Middle school dances
- After-school sports: Two grade checks will occur during a sports season, a 2.0 GPA must be maintained. See "Sports Policy."
- End of 8th grade: ineligible for promotion, 8th grade dinner dance

If a student ends a school year on Academic Probation, he/she will start the subsequent year on Academic Probation. CCDS may recommend Chico Unified School District's Academy for Change or other alternative education program if this intervention is not successful.
